Expected Result: When asking in a LCS widget that is on a card I would expect that the 'owner of me' would reference the card that the widget is on.

Observed Result: When asking in a LCS widget for the owner of me it reports some field.

Only 'the owner of the owner' references the card

I attach a livecodescript stack that illustrates the problem.

I compiled it using LC 10.0.0 dp6

If you compile the widget from the script only stack it will put the ownerships into a field. You might have to resize the widget manually.

The script is a modified version of Ali's Label Field.

If you open the script look for handler 'updateVisualControls' for the code.

At first sight I would consider this a bug.

I would like to ammend this report and would now say it is not a bug but a lack of documentation.

When I put

"put the long name of me into field 1 of this card" I get e.g.

group "com.livecode.widget.widgetname" of widget id 1003 of card id 1002 of stack
"LiveCode Extension Test Window"

Which lists "widget id 1003" in the path.

I falsely assumed that the group "com.livecode.widget.widgetname" would be the last
owner before the card but "Widget" is the last owner before card.

So technically it is correct that to find out on which card a script widget lives
to as for "the owner of the owner of me"
